Work will take place in both laboratory and field environments.

Responsibilities Include:

- Assisting with forage harvests**
- Weighing and processing samples for analysis**
- Plant species identification**
- Maintaining clean laboratory supplies**
- Working as part of an interdisciplinary team**
- Other duties as assigned**

Experience is helpful *but not necessary*. Any training required will be provided on the job. Students are expected to work well within a group, although certain situations may require working individually.
